

An Agreement to express the intentions of  
Connecticut Valley Arms, Inc. and  
Connecticut Valley Manufacturing, Inc.  
of Haddam, Connecticut, and  
Dikar s/Coop of Eibar, Spain

May 24, 1984

Whereas, Connecticut Valley Arms, Inc. and Connecticut Valley Manufacturing, Inc. (a wholly-owned subsidiary of CVA), (both referred to as CVA) of Haddam, Connecticut, imports and distributes replica muzzleloading firearms both assembled and in kit form throughout the United States, Canada and other parts of the world; and

Whereas, Dikar S.A. of Eibar, Spain has supplied CVA with all of the replica muzzleloading firearms except revolvers which CVA imported; and

Whereas, it is the intention of CVA and Dikar to continue the relationship which has existed between CVA and Dikar; Now therefore;

1. Dikar grants to CVA the exclusive right to import and sell in the United States, Canada and other designated parts of world for the term of two years replica muzzleloading firearms both assembled and in kit form manufactured in Spain and exported by Dikar.
2. CVA agrees to buy from Dikar during the next two years the replica muzzleloading firearms except revolvers both assembled and in kit form which CVA imports provided Dikar supplies such firearms, to CVA at prices and on terms which are competitive in the international marketplace. As was the case with revolvers, if CVA requires muzzleloading firearms that Dikar does not manufacture then CVA has the right to import such item(s) from others.
3. CVA agrees to buy from Dikar during the next two years a volume which will enable Dikar to provide prices and terms which are competitive in the international marketplace.
4. This agreement may be renewed for additional terms of years provided both CVA and Dikar consent.
